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**ORDER EXTENDING CERTAIN DEADLINES IN  
REVISED NSI ASBESTOS CLAIMS PROCEDURES**

Upon the motion (the “Motion”) of Charles M. Forman, chapter 7 trustee (the “Trustee”) for the estate of National Service Industries, Inc., for the entry of an order extending certain deadlines in the Revised NSI Asbestos Claims Procedures; and all parties in interest having received notice of the Motion; and a hearing having been held to consider the relief requested in the Motion (the “Hearing”); and upon the record of the Hearing and all of the proceedings before the Court; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor; it is hereby

ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED THAT:

1. The Motion is GRANTED.
2. All objections and responses, if any, to the Motion or the relief requested therein that have not been withdrawn, waived, or settled, and all reservations of rights included in such objections and responses, are overruled on the merits and denied with prejudice.
3. The Claim Deadline set forth in the Revised NSI Asbestos Claims Procedures is extended and shall continue through May 31, 2021.
4. The Trustee is authorized to grant, in his discretion, up to two (2) extensions of not more than thirty (30) days after the Claim Deadline for the filing of asbestos claim forms and


related documents under Section 5 of the Procedures. Extension requests must be written and submitted prior to May 31, 2021. All extensions shall be in written form signed by the Trustee.

5. Section 5.1(a)(1) of the Revised NSI Asbestos Claims Procedures is modified to authorize the Trustee to provide claimants with deficient claims an extension of the current 15 day time period for submitting corrective information, in his discretion, based on the nature of the deficiency.

6. Except as otherwise expressly modified by this Order and the Order Approving Revised Procedures for the Determination of Asbestos Related Claims Pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9019 entered on December 14, 2020 [Doc. No. 404], the terms of the August 17, 2020 Order Establishing Procedures for Determination of Asbestos Related Claims Pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9019 (Doc. 386), including without limitation paragraphs 7, 8, and 9, remain in full force and effect.

7. The Court shall retain jurisdiction to hear and determine all matters, claims, rights or disputes arising from or related to the implementation of this Order.
